Bid Documents for Construction of **Port Access Road Project** may be obtained from CCRMA or HNTB, at the contractors' expense. The Port Access Road Project is for the construction of a roadway consisting of grading, flexible base, lime treated subgrade, asphaltic concrete pavement, concrete pavement, metal beam guard fence, signing & pavement markings, cross culverts and bridge structures.

Sealed bids are to be sent to Cameron County Regional Mobility Authority (CCRMA) (2nd Floor), Attn: Pete Sepulveda, Cameron County Courthouse, 1100 East Monroe Street, Brownsville, Texas 78520 on or before **4:00 P.M. C.S.T., Thursday, May 27, 2010** at which time bids will be accepted. Bids will be opened at the same location (2nd Floor – Commissioners' Courtroom) at 4:01 P.M. C.S.T. (as per CCRMA time clock) on deadline due date. The bid opening is open to all interested bidders and the public.

Bids received after the previous mentioned date and time will not be considered and will be returned unopened. The CCRMA reserves the right to accept or reject all or any part of any bid; hold all bids for 45 days from due date of receipt without actions, waive any technicalities, require statements or evidence of bidder's qualifications, including financial statements, and award the bid which best serves the CCRMA. Acceptance will be based on low bid and qualification of contractor. Award of bid shall be subject to a final negotiated contract award by CCRMA.

A pre-bid meeting will be held on **Tuesday, May 11, 2010 at 1:30 P.M. C.S.T.**, at the Commissioners' Courtroom, Cameron County Courthouse (2nd Floor), 1100 East Monroe Street, Brownsville, Texas 78520. Attendance by representative of the general building contractors is **MANDATORY**. Sub-contractors and materials suppliers who expect to be associated with the project are invited to attend. Representatives of CCRMA will review plans, specifications, details, materials and requirements of the work.

Bid security in the amount of 5% of the largest possible total of proposals submitted must accompany each proposal in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Performance and payment bonds for 100% of the contract value will be required upon issuance of the contract.
